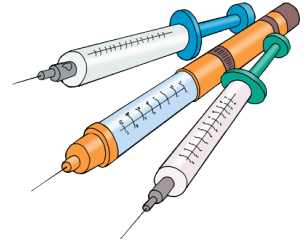




Sharps Disposal

Drop-off available 6 days a week



Thanks to the County of Lake Public Services Department, you can now dispose of your home-generated* sharps (needles and lancets) at the Lake County Transfer Station free of charge.

Drop off sharps with gate attendant
Monday—Saturday
7:30 am to 4:00 pm



*Home-generated sharps only. Maximum (1) one-gallon (or similar-sized) container per household per day.

Sharps must be properly packaged and sealed in an approved, puncture-proof container or they will not be accepted.

Milk cartons and detergent bottles are NOT acceptable sharps containers.

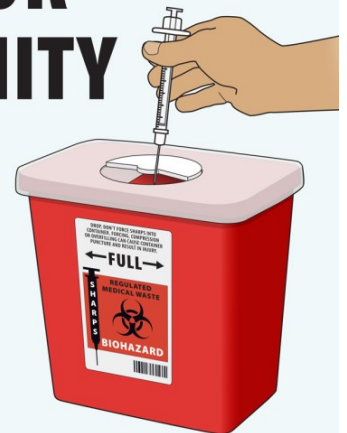
Sharps containers are available at local pharmacies.

Used sharps are hazardous waste. When not discarded properly they can cut and infect others. Protect your community by always discarding your used sharps in a sharps disposal container. Free sharps containers may be available through your doctor, hospital, health insurance or medication supplier. You can also buy one from your pharmacist or online.

DO NOT throw loose sharps in trash	DO NOT put sharps in recycling	DO NOT flush sharps down toilet	KEEP OUT of reach of children
