# EMPTY, CLEAN AND DRY

Recycling correctly is a great way for you to save money, but only if the recycling cart is filled solely with **empty, clean and dry** items for recycling. Dirty recycling increases our processing and disposal expenses. Recycling correctly helps us keep our costs lower, which means we can keep our rates lower too!

For example, in order for recycled paper to be useful, it must be kept dry and clean; and to do that, the containers we place in the blue recycling carts must also be **empty, clean and dry** or they can leak or drip onto other materials in the cart.

The recycled materials our drivers collect at your home or business are run over a sort line, and our workers hand sort the different container types before they are baled and sent to market. **Empty, clean and dry** recycling helps keep our workers happy and safe!

So, let's take another look at recycling. **Empty, clean and dry** is good for you and good for the environment. Best of all, it is easy!

## YES PLACE THESE ITEMS IN YOUR BLUE RECYCLE CART



Plastic bottles, jugs & tubs  
plastic containers 1 - 7



Milk, juice & soup cartons



Aluminum cans & foil,  
tin & metal containers



Glass food &  
beverage containers



Newspaper & inserts



Mail, mixed paper,  
catalogs & magazines



Chipboard, cardboard egg cartons,  
cereal & frozen food boxes



Corrugated cardboard  
(flattened)



Phone &  
paperback books



Scrap metal & pots & pans  
(no sharp objects)



Rigid plastics,  
buckets & plant pots



Aerosol cans - **EMPTY ONLY!**  
(non-hazardous materials only)



Shredded paper  
(place in clear plastic bag)

\* Please call 707-234-6400 for recycling opportunities in your area

- Recyclables must fit inside cart and lid must close.
- Recycling and garbage collection are on the same day.
- Cart must be within 3 feet of the street to be serviced.
- Material should be loose in the cart, not in plastic bags (except for shredded paper).

Be aware that human hands and valuable equipment sort these materials. Keep your recycling free of contamination by placing only clean recyclables in the blue cart. Contamination and overfill fees may be applied.
