- Paper Back Books *(soft-cover)*
- Paper Packaging
- Shredded Paper *(Place in Clear Plastic Bags)*
- Milk & Juice Cartons

- Hard-cover books
- Pizza Boxes
- Waxed Cardboard
- Waxed Paper
- Photographs
- Blueprint Paper
- Napkins

## PLASTICS



Please Check the Recycling Number on Plastic Items

### YES

- All CRV Containers (soda & water bottles)
- Plastic #1 (PET) - Water, soft drink, juice, beer, wine, mouthwash, and salad dressing bottles, peanut butter/jam jars, oven-ready and microwaveable meal trays, detergent and cleaner containers
- Plastic #2 (HDPE) - Plastic bags (grocery), opaque milk, water, and juice containers, bleach, detergent and shampoo bottles, garbage bags, dishes, and cereal box liners

### NO

- Plastic #3 (Polyvinyl chloride) - Shrink wrap, cling wrap, clamshell packaging, plastic toys, table cloths, squeeze bottles, shower curtains, flooring, PVC piping, vinyl siding and mini blinds
- Plastic #4 (LDPE) - Shopping bags, dry cleaning bags, flexible bottles and lids, bread, newspapers, fresh produce, household garbage, and frozen foods bags
- Plastic #5 (Polypropylene) - Yogurt, cottage cheese, margarine, syrup, take-out, and medicine containers, straws, bottle caps, and baby bottles.
- Plastic #6 (Polystyrene/Styrofoam) - Styrofoam food containers, egg cartons, disposable cups and bowls, take-out food containers, packing peanuts, and disposable cutlery
- Plastic #7 (Other) - Baby bottles, sippy cups, 3 and 5 gallon water bottles, metal food can liners, juice and ketchup containers, and carbonless paper receipts.

## METALS



### YES

- Aluminum Cans
- Tin & Steel Food Cans
- Small Scrap Metal
- Lids From Jars
- Aluminum Foil & Pie Tins
- Empty Aerosol Cans *(non-toxic materials only)*

### NO

- Batteries
- All electronic waste (computers, televisions, radios, phones, small appliances)

## OTHER

### NO

- Garbage
- Food Contaminated Materials or Food Waste
- Diapers
- Pet Waste
- Mini Blinds
- Medical Waste/Sharps
- CDs, DVDs, Videos, Cassettes
- All Hazardous Waste (motor oil, filters, auto batteries, paints, thinners, pesticides, etc.)

## GLASS



### YES

- Clear & colored food and beverage jars & bottles with lids removed.

### NO

- Window Glass
- Mirrors
- Drinking glasses
- Ceramic mugs
- Light bulbs
- Fluorescent tubes

Please empty all food and liquid from containers. All recyclables must be empty, clean, and dry when put in the cart or bin. Material should be loose in the cart, not in plastic bags (except for shredded paper). All recyclables must fit inside cart or bin. For residential customers with a blue lid cart, collection is made the same day as garbage service.
