# STOP! IT'S TOO TOXIC TO TRASH!

At your home or business, you likely use products that even at their end of life are still considered hazardous waste. We call this material Household Hazardous Waste (HHW), and there are many types found in our daily lives:

- CORROSIVES:** acids, bases, batteries, drain or pile clog remover
- IGNITABLE:** paints (dry or wet), petroleum-based products, polishes, gasoline
- REACTIVE:** pool chemicals, hydrogen peroxide, iodine, perchlorates
- TOXICS:** poisons, pesticides, gardening chemicals, ammonia, solvents
- MISCELLANEOUS:** propane, helium, small oxygen tanks, smoke detectors, fluorescent lamps

Please **DON'T DISPOSE** of these items in your waste bins – it's dangerous for sanitation workers and harmful to the environment. You can safely divert HHW from the landfill by taking it to the following locations for proper disposal.

The **Lake County Transfer Station** (707-234-6400, [www.CandSwaste.com](http://www.CandSwaste.com)) accepts electronic waste, household and automotive batteries, motor oil and oil filters, antifreeze, paint, and properly packaged, home generated sharps.

The mobile **HAZ-DROP** program collects household hazardous waste from Lake County residents the third Friday and Saturday of each month from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at rotating ends of the lake.
