COMPOST & MULCH

Conserve water by incorporating compost and mulch into your yard and garden. Recycled landscape materials are available in bulk and by the bag at the Ukiah Transfer Station, located at 3151 Taylor Drive, or call us at (707) 234-6400 to arrange for large order delivery.

SPRING CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION

April 5 - April 9, 2021

City of Ukiah customers may place up to seven (7) additional bags or 32-gallon cans of leaves at the curb on your normal collection day this week. Emptied bags and cans will be left on the curb.

AVOID CONTAMINATION & EXCESS TRASH FEES

Do your part to keep your recycling free of contamination. Place only clean recyclables in the blue cart and trash in your gray cart. If you have more trash than will fit in your container, please call us ahead of time at (707) 234-6400 to arrange for extra trash collection. There is a charge for additional material. Thank you.

Empty your kitchen scraps into your Mixed Organic Waste cart to be collected weekly. We will transport these materials to be turned into valuable compost. Worried about a mess in your kitchen? No need to stress, just add some newspaper, a paper bag, or paper egg cartons to the bottom of your kitchen scrap pail to help soak up any extra moisture.
